In addition, by signing this form each author indicates that he or she has had full "freedom of investigation" before, during, and after this study. "Freedom of investigation" is defined as freedom from outside interests in controlling the design of the study, acquisition of data, collection, analysis, and interpretation of data, and having freedom to fully disclose all results.

Each author must sign this form to certify that none of the material in this manuscript has been published previously in either print or electronic form, and that none of this material is currently under consideration for publication elsewhere. This includes symposia, transactions, books, articles published by invitation, posting in electronic format, and preliminary publications of any kind except an abstract of 400 words or fewer.

(2) You may not update the post-print text or replace it with a proof or with the final published version. (3) You may not include the post-print or any other version of the article in any commercial site or in any repository owned or operated by any third party.
